Automobile Property

Agent/Broker

•Policy backdated prior to loss date and/or theft of premium dollars intended for payment of coverage.

Auto Property/Vandalism

•Vehicle or motor home vandalism including such items as car rims, stereo equipment and engine parts.

Embezzlement

•Theft or misappropriation of funds placed in one's trust or belonging to one's employer.

Inflated Damages

•Damages inflated or exaggerated, non-existent or pre-existing; excessive billing of vehicle body parts or repair work.

Other Auto Property

•Any other auto-related circumstance not listed above involving the presentation of false documents to support an insurance claim.

Property Faked Damages

•Damages to vehicle exaggerated, non-existent, pre-existing or vehicle damaged at a later point in time.

Trailered Watercraft Arson

•Burning of a watercraft while transported on trailer.

Tailored Watercraft/Theft Damage

•Watercraft stolen or damaged while being transported on trailer.

Vehicle Arson

•Burning of a vehicle or motor home.

Vehicle Theft

•Reporting a vehicle or motor home theft for the purposes of filing a false insurance claim.
